

ACROSS:

- 9. The whetū (star) connected to hopes and dreams for the future (often called the wishing star).
- 11. The whetū (star) connected with our dead. She is the star who guides the spirits of those who have passed to their place in the sky.
- 14. A food grown in the ground and offered as kai (food) to replenish the whetū (star) Tupuānuku.

DOWN:

- 1. The whetū (star) connected with the moana (ocean) and the creatures who live within.
- You catch these sea creatures in tāruke (pots) and offer then as kai (food) to replenish the whetū Waitā.
- 3. The whetū (star) connected with kai (foods) from the sky.
- 4. The whetū (star) associated with the wind.
- 5. The whetū (star) connected with well-being and the mother of the stars of Matariki.
- 8. The whetū (star) connected with fresh water (rivers, streams, and lakes) and the creatures who live there.
- 10. The Māori kupu (word) for star!
- 12. The character from Island of Mystery who is the tuakana (elder sister) to the character Rangi. She is organising the umu kohukohu for her village.
- 13. A large wood pigeon who gets fat eating ripe miro berries. Given as kai to replenish the whetū Tupuārangi.
